

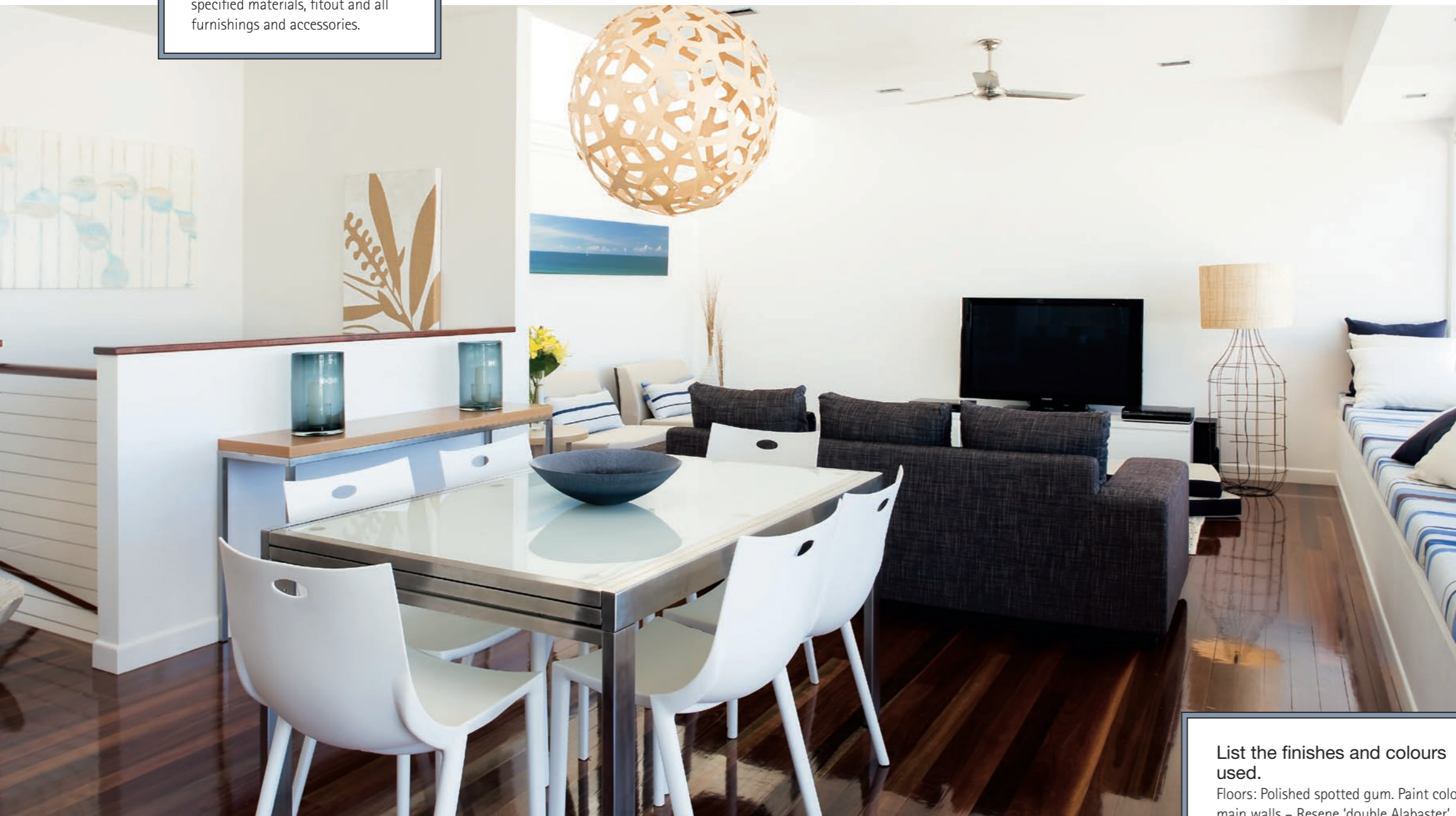
**Describe the project when you started it.**

Futari Design were engaged by the owners to work on this new home project in conjunction with the architects/builders. Futari Design specified materials, fitout and all furnishings and accessories.



**What was your clients' brief to you?**

To create a 'home away from home' in a contemporary beach house with a simple and uncluttered style that felt very different to their everyday living. The home also had to handle two or three families at once in a relaxed, open, warm and inviting environment. We also had to ensure connection to the outdoor living areas and pool. Their colour preferences were for neutrals, with colour added in furnishings, and they wanted the home to be energy and water efficient.

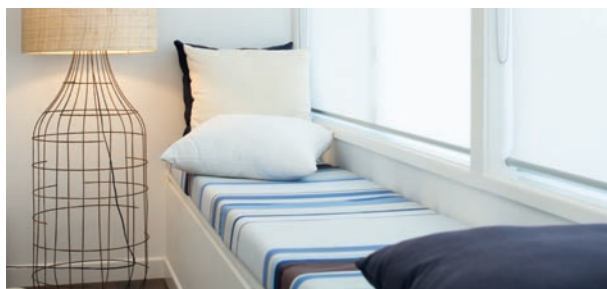


**List the finishes and colours used.**

Floors: Polished spotted gum. Paint colours: main walls – Resene 'double Alabaster' feature walls – Resene 'Napa' and quarter 'Napa' Resene 'Tuna' (charcoal/navy feature) ceilings and cornices – Resene 'Alabaster'.  
 Artwork: Icebox Art paintings, and Peter Budd photography inspired by local area.  
 Window furnishings double roll blinds – full blackout and sunscreen. Automated shutters.

Having a blank canvas to work with, the coastal location, the fact that it is a family holiday home, and the relationship that developed with the client.
